

Notice - Public Awareness of Electrical Safety Survey

Orillia Power's 2014 scorecard includes a Public Safety measure, comprised of three components: Public Awareness of Electrical Safety, Compliance with Ontario Regulation 22/04, and the Serious Electrical Incident Index. Orillia Power will be conducting a Public Awareness of Electrical Safety Survey from **January 20 – February 29, 2016**. The results will be included in its 2015 scorecard.

UtilityPULSE, a market research firm representing Orillia Power will be contacting residents of the City of Orillia over the age of 18 to ask them questions that will measure their level of awareness of key electrical safety precautions within Orillia Power's service territory. Standardized questions have been designed specifically to focus on public awareness related to the electrical incidents (fatalities, critical injuries and injuries) involving utility equipment that have most frequently occurred in Ontario in the last decade.
